The PCFA Board of Directors will ensure that all safety procedures relating to Covid-19 will be followed by everyone in attendance at the 2022 Festival. This includes proof of vaccination for all those eligible at the time of the Festival. A detailed list of applicable procedures and protocols will be announced well ahead of the Festival.

RULES & PROTOCOL FOR COMPOSITION CLASSES

1. The student composition may be in any style or combination of voice/instrument and piano.
2. It is expected that the student composer will perform his or her own composition.
3. In the case of a piano and vocal composition the student composer may have another individual perform the vocal or piano part.
4. A copy of the composition **MUST** be provided for the adjudicator. Either a legible hand written copy or an electronically produced copy will be accepted.
5. Students may enter ONE composition class only.
6. Memorization is **NOT** required.
7. All composition classes are **COMPETITIVE** classes

AWARDS

Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place. However, regardless of the number of entries, medals will be withheld unless the following marks are obtained:

1st Place - 80%

2nd Place - 75%

3rd Place - 70%

When a gold medal recipient is awarded a mark of 90 or over, this achievement will be recognized as GOLD EXCELLENCE and a gold excellence award seal will be placed on the certificate.

Certificates and adjudication sheets will be given to all participants.

RULES & PROTOCOL FOR IMPROVISATION CLASSES

1. These are non-competitive classes for students who have the inclination to improvise or create their own arrangements to demonstrate their skills.
2. Students **MUST** ENTER AT THEIR CURRENT LEVEL OF STUDY OR ONE (1) GRADE HIGHER.
3. Students will receive a melody in a jazz/blues style on which to improvise. This will be available for pickup from the Secretary's desk one (1) day prior to the scheduled class. Students must work without any assistance.
4. Students may enter ONE improvisation class only.
5. Maximum performance time is two (2) minutes.
6. Students will receive an adjudication only with no medals awarded.
7. All competitors should be present fifteen (15) minutes before scheduled class time.

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RULES & PROTOCOL FOR PIANO SOLO WITH ACCOMPANIMENT CLASSES

1. These are **COMPETITIVE** classes.
2. Competitors **MUST** enter at CURRENT LEVEL OF STUDY OR ONE (1) GRADE HIGHER.
3. These are **OWN CHOICE** classes with electronic accompaniment or “backing track”.
4. Selections must be memorized. If music is referred to during the performance, adjudication will be given but **NO MARK** will be awarded.
5. Students must provide an **ORIGINAL COPY** of the selection for the Adjudicator’s use. This selection must be delivered to the Secretary prior to the beginning of the class and recovered immediately afterward. If an original copy is not provided, an adjudication will be given but **NO MARK** will be awarded.
6. Students must provide their own equipment for the backing track and it must be ready to play when called upon. **NO** wi-fi is provided so accompanying tracks must be in a stored format.
7. Students may enter ONE (1) Piano Solo With Accompaniment Class only.
8. All competitors should be present fifteen (15) minutes before scheduled class time.
